

# Faith Ringgold

Over the course of six decades, American artist, author, and activist Faith Ringgold has worked in a variety of media and modes—from quilts and paintings to performance and children's books—shaping a narrative that is as personal as it is political. An incomparable visual storyteller, Ringgold is known for her mordant depictions of the racial and social realities of the African American experience in her multifaceted practice.

This exhibition was organized by the Serpentine Galleries, London, in 2019 and travelled to Bildmuseet, Umeå, Sweden in 2020. This survey is the artist's first one-person institutional exhibition in Europe. Glenstone Museum is the only United States venue for this exhibition tour.
